Overview

The aim of this workshop is to enhance practitioners understanding of the importance of meaningful involvement of very young children in decision making and the huge benefits of participation to children, staff, families and society in general.

Who is it for?

This is a full day workshop aimed at anyone working with babies, young children and /or their families

Outcomes

By the end of the session practitioners will:

- Have identified current good practice within their setting that can be used as a foundation for developing participation and involvement in decision making
- Have developed their thinking around effective strategies for involving babies and young children in making decisions about issues and choices affecting them
- Understand the meaning of participation and be able to distinguish between the different levels of participation
- Develop creative ways of communicating with children in order to understand the choices that babies and children make and the ways in which these choices are communicated
- Develop their understanding of the role of parents in supporting children's decision making skills and the importance of involving parents in work within the setting to encourage their understanding
- Have identified effective methods for active listening and understand the huge benefits of listening to young children
- Be able to make clear links between the EYFS and actively listening to young children
