The course considers occupancy, cashflow, budgets, pricing, breakeven analysis and also covers external pressures which can affect viability.

Who is it for?

The workshop is ideal for managers or deputy managers of childcare settings who have a basic knowledge of business planning and who may be affected by sustainability issues.

Outcomes

At the end of the workshop participants will:

- understand what information needs to be monitored in the business
- understand factors affecting income and expenditure
- be able to identify ways of improving sustainability
- be able to identify when to take action
