Overview

- Be able to develop practical ideas for promoting and upholding children's rights
- Identify ways of developing meaningful participation in children's centres
- Be able to promote the Act to staff teams and encourage open discussion about how this should impact on their work with families and children
- Think about how children's rights should underpin policy development
